



Lock Down in the Capital City

As of February 20th, Covid-19 began to spread quickly in Phnom Penh city and several provinces. Consequently, by the end of March the capital city is in full lock down. This surge is more serious as greater numbers of people are being infected: more that 400 people per day. However, the government and doctors are working very hard as it spread mostly among factory workers. Please keep praying for our workers and pray that God will protect people around the world. The HCG team really thank God for keeping us and our listener groups safe from Covid-19.


Our TWR-Cambodia office was closed for a month, so we worked from home. However, by mid May, most of the areas in Phnom Penh are open, except for RED zones in which they still cannot travel yet. On the other hand, vaccines for Covid-19 have been provided to people in the city and some provinces. We still need your prayers as the number of new cases is still high.



May God Protect Cambodia!










Lock Down in the Capital City: Food Offering/Community Table

As part of Phnom Penh City is still designated as Red Zone, we have planned in May to work with one family, who are our listeners living there, to cook for the people in that area. They will cook only on weekends to prepare one package per person. They provide 50 to 70 package for free every week. We plan to do this until they can get back to the normal life. As they cannot go to work, they have no income. We hope it will provide extra help to supplement the limited food the government is providing for them. We decided to cook the food instead of giving fresh food (vegetable and meat) because it costs less, and we can help more people. Furthermore, we hope and pray that people living in that area will be able to hear the Gospel. Some of the children were interested in Good News Reader during the first week of sharing the food. We pray that there will be a cell group created there soon.











Funding Support From Phillip Bank Cambodia

We thank God that Phillip Bank in Cambodia began to provide funding support from April 2021 for broadcasting on four FM radio stations. Therefore, we need to produce short spots for our sponsors and add some lessons related to financial topics into our programs. We think it is such a great opportunity as we will interview officers from Phillip Bank who are the experts on how to make money work for the family and especially for the children. However, our format of the program is still the same as we still have Bible story telling, kid's songs, and lessons for health or finance. This is what we are going to do; we will choose financial topics which be helpful for our listeners, and then Phillip Bank officers will provide us the lesson or an interview. For some topics we don't need to interview the people from the bank, we might find other speakers who are a good role models instead.

HCG program is on air with 16 FM stations which are supported 12 by churches in South Australia and four by Phillip Bank Cambodia. We thank God for blessing the HCG program. We also keep praying for our donors as they have a heart for children in Cambodia. May God bless them and bless through their hands as well.










The most reached topic was about Good Friday and Easter Day.











Number of Responses from Listeners






Children are writing letter after listening to HCG program.


